

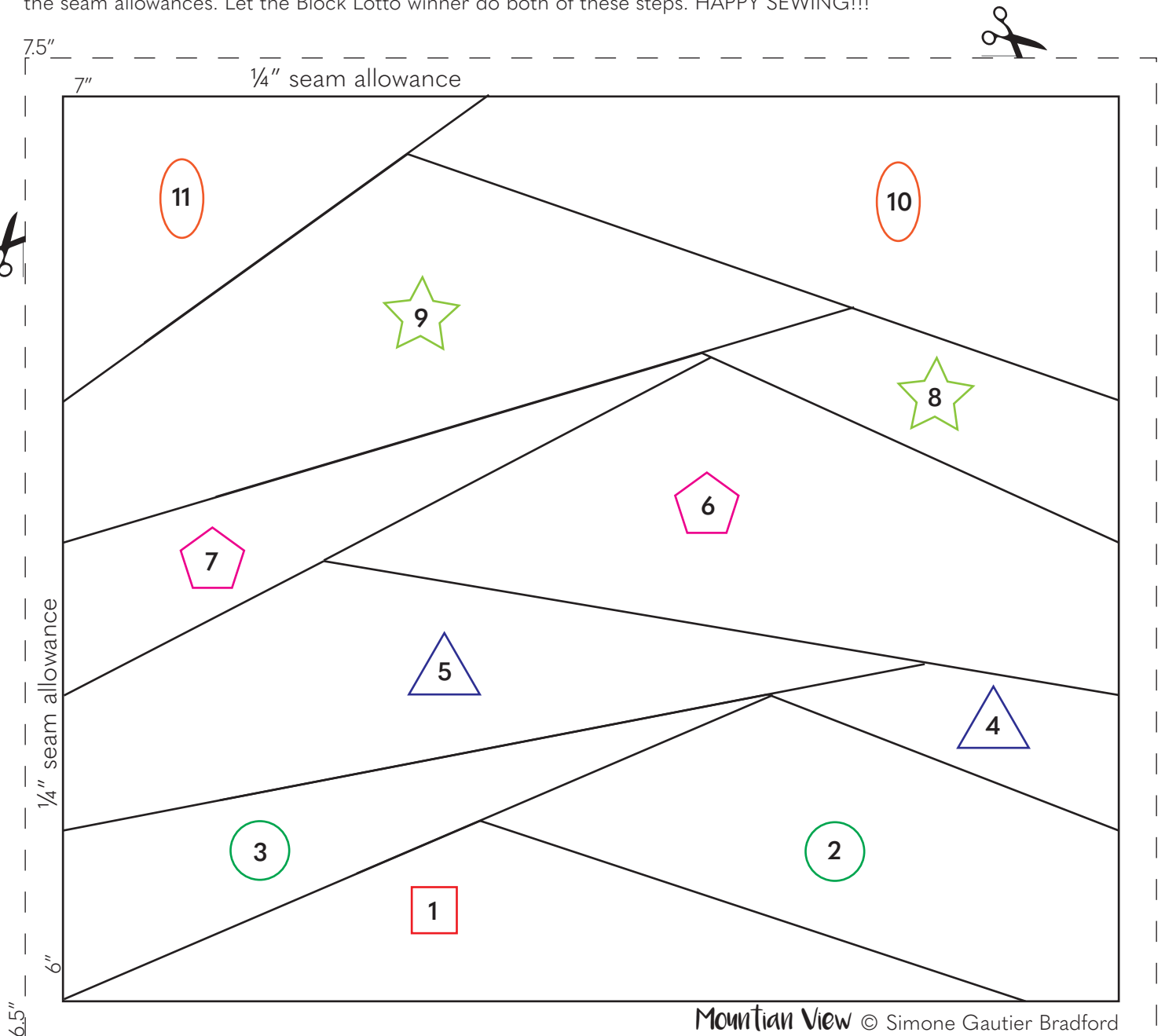


# Mountain View

Mountain View is a foundation paper pieced block (FPP). Overall dimensions including seam allowances are 7.5"x6.5".

1. Print your Mountain View block template onto thin copy paper or tracing paper.
2. Rough cut template. Do not cut out Mountain View block template on dashed lines. Save that for the end.
3. Prepare all fabric by cutting 2 1/2" strips of your chosen fabric, OR make it easy and use a pre-cut jelly roll.
4. Change your sewing machine stitch length to 15-20 stitches per inch. Stitches should be big enough to get a seam ripper in between them.
5. Sew fabric onto the back of Mountain view block template beginning with #1 and finishing with #11. For an awesome tutorial on FPP please go to <https://www.violetcraft.com/blog/man-sewing>
6. Use the same fabric for areas marked with matching shapes. Example: 2 & 3 have circles around them. Both of these areas should be sewn in the same fabric, and so on.
7. If this block is for IE MQG Block Lotto LEAVE the paper attached to the block & DO NOT trim the block down on the seam allowances. Let the Block Lotto winner do both of these steps. HAPPY SEWING!!!

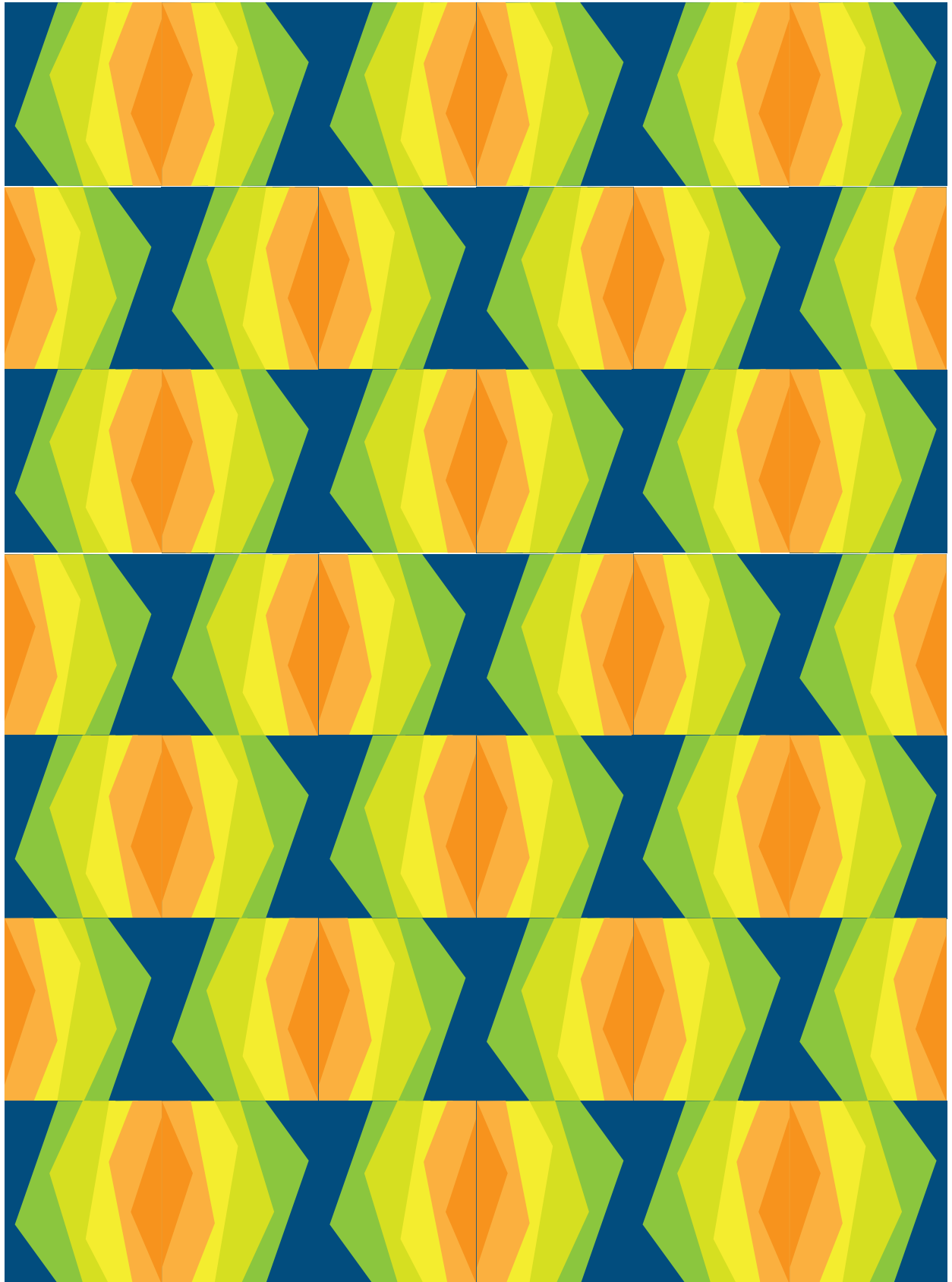




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Vertical 1/2 Off Set
